The **key objective of the program** was to **develop problem solving competence** amongst the executives to enable them solve chronic business problems faced in their work area. In line with MIQ's strong emphasis on '**learning by doing**', the modules were covered through a mix of class room sessions, exercises and group discussions facilitated by MIQ faculty, Mr. Sharath Chandra Peddi and Mr. Rohit Pathak.

The **senior management representatives from Siemens, Mr. Devidas Kulkarni, Vice President – Operations, Mr. Vaibhav Khandekar, Head - Manufacturing and Mr. Bharat Jain, Head - Quality** were also present during the program.

Addressing the participants, **Mr. Devdas Kulkarni, Vice President – Operations**, emphasized on the importance of this quality initiative for Siemens, given the fact that the plant had been identified as the preferred source for exports to Siemens world-wide.

Each participant will now **apply the learning from the program in his / her work area through a QC story project**. The MIQ team will facilitate this through continuous on-site reviews and guidance.
